## Summer Term 2021 Newsletter

Welcome to the Summer term at Nursery. We look forward to enjoying sunny days outdoors in the nursery gardens. Please make sure to **send a sunhat and put sunscreen on your child before dropping them off** at nursery, we are outdoors everyday.

Thank you to everyone who bought items on the Easter craft stall. The monies raised, along with staff donations, have been donated to Alice House hospice in memory of Jenny Gibson. Nana Jenny was a long standing member of staff and a volunteer, who contributed so much towards the nursery. Her kindness and generosity will never be forgotten.

Following COVID restrictions we continue to work as two bubbles with the 3-4s separate from Blue teddies. We have decided to move back to the original nursery arrival and drop off windows. The 3-4s main door and 2s garden gate will be open from **8.45-9am for drop off** and you may come anytime within this. Collection times will revert to **11.30-11.45am** collection window for AM only children and **2.30-2.45pm** for full day children. Again **you may come anytime within this window to collect. Please continue to socially distance and wear a face covering.**

This term we will be completing a sponsored obstacle course in the nursery. This will raise money to pay for all the children to enjoy a special end of term event. Sponsor forms will be sent home in the coming weeks.

The children will be looking closely at growth and lifecycles, observing changes first hand in the nursery gardens and sharing in the wonders of caterpillars, tadpoles and hatching chicks.

We will be organising Gardening events for small groups of parents or grandparents to come and plant with their children and to help prepare the different areas of the nursery grounds and greenhouse for the summer.

We ask for donations of seeds, plants, compost, planters/pots etc. It is a lovely opportunity to come along and work with your child. You do not need to have any gardening skills, just a willingness to help.

After half term we will be developing the use of our reclaimed model area. We hope to be able to invite dads or granddads to join us in nursery during June for a *Builder Buddy* event. Throughout this time the nursery will be transformed with model making materials for the children to explore with their adult.

Parent consultations will be arranged for July, these may be via the telephone (depending upon Coronavirus restrictions). More information will be sent home prior to July.

During the final week of term we hope to be able to hold a 'Leavers Celebration' event for all the children who are moving on to Primary School. This will give us an opportunity to congratulate all the children on all their hard work and achievements during their time at Rosemary Lane.

As usual all the dates for the term are included in the calendar attached. As each event grows closer you will receive a letter with more information on times etc. For parents of children returning in September there are some dates for transition back to nursery included too.

A few polite reminders

- Please name all items of clothing including hats and shoes.
- Please bring a coat to nursery everyday. We have an open door policy so children go outside everyday.
- Snack money is £2 for 15hour children, £2.50 for 30hour children
